- Memorize the song "I Will Remember Who I Really Am."

EARLY TO BED, EARLY TO RISE BADGE

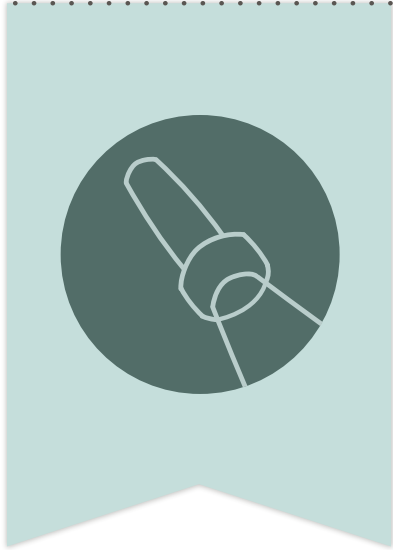
- Memorize the song "Early to Be, Early To Rise."
- Find D&C 88:124 in the scriptures and read the verse together with a parent!
- Go to bed a little bit early tonight and wake up a little bit early tomorrow morning.



FAITH BADGE

- Memorize the song "Faith is Like Planting a Tiny Seed."
- Find Alma 32:41 in the scriptures and read the verses together with a parent!
- Draw a seed on a blank sheet of paper. Do something that shows faith in Jesus Christ, then draw yourself watering the seed!



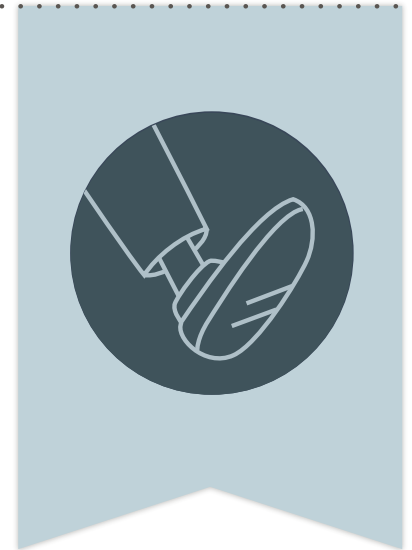


IF I TUNE IN, I WILL HEAR HIM BADGE

- Memorize the song "If I Tune In, I Will Hear Him."
- Find John 14:26 in the scriptures and read the verse together with a parent!
- Say a prayer and tell Heavenly Father that you love Him and say anything else that you would like to say. Sit reverently for a few minutes after your prayer with your eyes closed and try to listen with your heart.

SMALL AND SIMPLE MEANS BADGE

- Memorize the song "Small and Simple Means."
- Find Alma 37:6 in the scriptures and read the verse together with a parent!
- Do a household chore by breaking it into smaller pieces. (For example, you could put away the dishes one dish at a time, or clean your room by putting away one thing at a time.)



REPENTANCE IS TURNING AROUND BADGE

- Memorize the song "Repentance is Turning Around."
- Find Heleman 7:17 in the scriptures and read the verse together with a parent!
- Stand next to an image of Jesus Christ and face away from Him with your back turned to Jesus. Now turn around to look at Jesus while you say out loud "repentance is turning around!"



SERVE ONE ANOTHER BADGE

- Memorize the song "If We Serve One Another, We Are Serving the Lord."
- Find Mosiah 2:17 in the scriptures and read the verse together with a parent!
- Do something to serve a family member. Try to be extra sneaky so they won't know who did it!

TRUTH WILL MAKE ME FREE BADGE

- Memorize the song "The Truth Will Make Me Free."
- Find John 8:32 in the scriptures and read the verse together with a parent!
- For the rest of the day, give yourself a thumbs up every time you tell the truth!



I'M RESPONSIBLE FOR MY ATTITUDE BADGE

- Memorize the song "I'm Responsible for My Attitude."
- Find Proverbs 17:21 in the scriptures and read the verse together with a parent!
- Make a list of five good things that happened today.

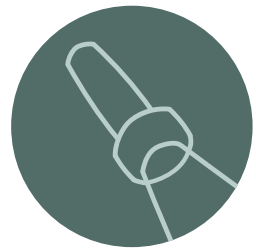




PATIENCE BRINGS REWARDS BADGE
